

**BOROUGH OF AVON-BY-THE-SEA
EXECUTIVE ORDER 2020-01
PURSUANT TO DECLARATION
OF STATE OF EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, on March 19, 2020 the Borough of Avon by the Sea issued a Declaration of State of Emergency as a result of Coronavirus Disease ("Covid-19") which has spread globally and throughout New Jersey;

WHEREAS, Covid-19 is a contagious and, potentially fatal, respiratory disease cause by the virus; and

WHEREAS, on March 9, 2020, the Governor of the State of New Jersey declared a Public Health Emergency and State of Emergency in the State of New Jersey pursuant to Executive Order No. 103; and

WHEREAS, for the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Borough of Avon by Sea, it is necessary to reduce overcrowding, the congregation of people, traffic and spread of Covid-19 within the Borough of Avon by the Sea; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Declaration of State of Emergency, and the laws of the State of New Jersey and ordinances of the Borough of Avon by the Sea; and the general police power of the Borough,

I ORDER and DIRECT as follows:

PARKING:

1. Diagonal parking on the public streets shall be prohibited.

BEACHFRONT:

2. The boardwalk shall remain closed.


Vehicles parked in violation of item No. 1 shall be towed at the owner's expense and ticketed.

Individuals in violation of No. 2 will be subject to fines and penalties, including but not limited to, imprisonment for a term not to exceed 6 months, fines not to exceed \$1,000.00, or both and expulsion from the beach.

THIS ORDER SHALL TAKE EFFECT ON MAY 1, 2020 AND SHALL REMAIN
IN EFFECT UNTIL SUCH TIME THAT THE DECLARATION IS RESCINDED.
